

POLICY REGARDING DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent of Schools to require each building principal and non-instructional supervisor to develop a school emergency management plan in compliance with Commission of Education Regulation 155.13. The plan shall provide for sheltering, evacuation, early dismissal, written notification to students and staff, an annual drill, and coordination with local and county emergency preparedness administrators. These several plans shall be submitted to the School District's Emergency Planning Committee for approval and incorporation into the overall School District's Emergency Management Plan. The approved plan will be communicated to all local government agencies that may be required to interact with the district in the event of a disaster emergency.
