

GRADE EIGHT ACCELERATION FOR DIPLOMA CREDIT

Grade eight students in Schodack Central Schools shall have the opportunity to take high school courses in mathematics and one other subject as determined by the Board of Education: English, social studies, languages other than English, art, music, career and technical education subjects, and science. Credit for such courses will be awarded in accordance with the Commissioner’s regulations. In order to begin any high school courses in the eighth grade, the Superintendent of Schools, or his or her designee, must determine that the student has demonstrated readiness in the subject(s) of the high school courses, as determined by regulations of the Superintendent.
