Dear Parents, Guardians, and Friends,

On Friday, May 6th, 2022, the Class of 2023 will present the Maple Hill High School Junior/Senior Prom from 7:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. at Old Daley on Crooked Lake. The address of Old Daley on Crooked Lake is 2339 NY-43, Averill Park, NY 12018. In order to provide family and friends with an opportunity for photographs and viewing, we will once again hold our own promenade at Maple Hill Junior/Senior High School from 4:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. on May 6th, 2022. All students attending prom must attend the promenade. In addition, attendees who schedule a photo appointment will have the opportunity for the professional photographer to take their formal picture at this time.

This is a school-sponsored event. All school rules must be followed and will be strictly enforced. Smoking, use of alcohol or other prohibited substances will not be permitted. We ask for your support with pre-prom and post-prom activities. The Junior-Senior Prom is an age appropriate event and, as is the case with all school dances, attendees must be in at least ninth grade. A prom information sheet is included in this letter.

As in the past, the SADD chapter of Maple Hill High School, under the advisement of Jennifer Delaney, will be hosting a post-prom party and all students will be provided details at a later date. This event will be open to all prom attendees and their guests. Included in this letter is the “Contract for Life.” In order for students to purchase a prom ticket, this document must be signed by both the student and a guardian. The form must be presented and signed at the time of the ticket purchase. Without this completed Contract for Life, students will not be allowed to purchase a ticket.

General Prom Information 2022

Time: 7:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m.

Theme: Enchanted Forest

Location: Old Daley on Crooked Lake, 2339 NY-43, Averill Park, NY 12018

Directions from Maple Hill Junior/Senior High School: Turn right onto Maple Hill Rd. Turn left onto US-9. Take a slight left turn onto Columbia Tpke. Turn right onto E Schodack Rd. Turn right onto Biittig Rd. Keep right onto Biittig Rd. Turn right onto Sheer Rd. Turn left onto NY-43. The destination will be on your left.

Pre-Prom Promenade and Photography:

- The Pre-Prom Promenade will take place at the High School from 4:00 – 6:15 p.m. This is an opportunity for parents, family, and friends to take photographs and view prom participants. Limos can drop students off and then park at the District Office (old Middle School).
- Only students attending the prom will be admitted into the gymnasium for professional prom photographs; parents and guests will be restricted to outside. An alternate plan will be communicated should we have inclement weather. Students must be present at their scheduled time for photographs to be taken; if a student or couple misses their assigned time, they will not be photographed.
- The students will sign-up for their walkthrough/photograph time when they purchase their ticket.
- The professional photos will be available to be ordered through our photographer's website (Upstate Images). More information, including the link to the website for our specific event, will be announced as we get closer to the event.

Parents, Family, and Friends

- Parents, family, and friends will **not** be admitted into the gymnasium; photos may be taken outside **only** in order to facilitate the professional photographer and to remain on schedule.
- **No admittance at Old Daley at Crooked Lake;** photography opportunities and visitation at pre-prom promenade only.

Prom Tickets: On sale starting April 11th through April 14th. Cost-\$85 (Checks payable to Student Activities Account).

- Please try to have exact change if paying with cash.
- All attendees must sign a "Contract for Life" signed by both the attendee and a guardian to purchase a ticket. "Contract for Life" is attached and also available in Mrs. Castle's Room (Room 109) or Mrs. Delaney's office.
- All attendees will reserve their table seating at the time of purchasing tickets. You can reserve seats for groups of 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, or 12 on a first come, first serve basis.

Guests

- Must be in at least ninth grade as this is a junior-senior prom and a high school function
- Must register by name and affiliation (school, etc.) when the ticket is purchased
- Must have a completed guest pass (attached) which has to be presented at time of ticket purchase in order to buy the ticket

CONTRACT FOR LIFE

A Foundation for Trust and Caring

This Contract is designed to facilitate communication between young people and their parents about potentially destructive decisions related to alcohol, drugs, peer pressure, and behavior. The issues facing young people today are often too difficult for them to address alone. SADD believes that effective parent-child communication is critically important in helping young adults to make healthy decisions.

YOUNG PERSON

I recognize that there are many potentially destructive decisions I face every day and commit to you that I will do everything in my power to avoid making decisions that will jeopardize my health, my safety and overall well-being, or your trust in me. I understand the dangers associated with the use of alcohol and drugs and the destructive behaviors often associated with impairment.

By signing below, I pledge my best effort to remain free from alcohol and drugs; I agree that I will never drive under the influence; I agree that I will never ride with an impaired driver; and I agree that I will always wear a seat belt.

Finally, I agree to call you if I am ever in a situation that threatens my safety and to communicate with you regularly about issues of importance to both of us.

YOUNG PERSON

PARENT (or Caring Adult)

I am committed to you and to your health and safety. By signing below, I pledge to do everything in my power to understand and communicate with you about the many difficult and potentially destructive decisions you face.

Further, I agree to provide for you safe, sober transportation home if you are ever in a situation that threatens your safety and to defer discussions about that situation until a time when we can both have a discussion in a calm and caring manner.

I also pledge to you that I will not drive under the influence of alcohol or drugs, I will always seek safe, sober transportation home, and I will always wear a seat belt.
