6. REPORTS

A. Claims Auditor Annual Report

Sandra Hall presented her process to audit accounts payable, payroll and extracurricular accounts throughout the year. She indicated that there were no major findings. Errors were typographical or missing signatures.

A. Board Discussion

The board asked about Kindergarten numbers, the answer was at this time, there are 39 students enrolled for Kindergarten in the upcoming school year.

Kurt Maier asked about feedback on cursive writing

Alyssa Sabbatino answered that every student in 7th grade will learn cursive in an elective in the fall. The business department and English departments have been asked to bring in cursive in their classes.

Daniel Grandinetti expressed that the enrollment number is concerning, expressed that we have good teachers but we are losing students to private and charter schools. The low enrollment number is unsustainable.

A. District Updates

- BOE Student Representative Jason Chevrier thanked Luke Hoffman for his leadership as Student Representative to the Board of Education.
- Capital Project Update Phase 1 Capital work has begun, more work will continue over the summer and again next summer, the district is preparing for bids for Phase 2.
- Graduation Jason asked the board to let him know if they would be attending. Weather is being watched in case it needs to be moved indoors.
- SRO Update Meeting with the Town Supervisor took place, he has asked for time to speak with the police department to see if they can support that, if that is not an option we will reach out to Rensselaer County.
- Enrollment Report attached for review.

B. Building Updates

- Castleton Elementary School Flag Day was a huge turnout this year. Field Days for Gr. 3, 4, 5 & 6 have been completed, 6th grade field trip to NYS was a nice trip, 5th grade students went to the Adirondacks, 6th grade moving up is next Thursday and Friday is the end of the year Monthly Moring Assembly. Hope Wins Festival with 5 different authors took place, authors spent time with kids, stayed after and signed books, 3rd grade World Fair, 6th grade interdisciplinary project on biomes.
- Maple Hill Jr/Sr High School 7-12 Students were included in the Hope Wins with author visits, For a Senior prank this year, the Seniors blocked off a big circle in the parking lot and barbecued breakfast. Fun to see them all working together and smiling in the morning before school. IReady testing has been completed and data is being reviewed. Students created TED talks where students pick a topic important to them and create a TED talk to present. Seniors left for a class trip for 3 days, a lot of memories were made, 8th grade class night will take place with a dance after, and students participated in Equine Therapy.

C. Student Representative Update

Thanked the board for having him this year and supporting his ideas, it has been a pleasure. He highlighted the different field trips that students attended, concerts that have taken place, the Cabaret, movie night outside at the high school, and he encouraged the district to hold more. Teachers vs. Seniors basketball game raised \$1000 for charity, and he invited Linden Rosenberger to talk about Mental Health in Schools.

Linden shared information about Mental Health days for students, how many they might have and what the approval process could be. The board was asked to consider policy to allow mental health days for students.

There was discussion on how the high school is handling separating the 7th & 8th grade from the upperclassmen.

There was discussion about the Science Teacher absence at the 7th grade level and how the elementary school will address if there is only need for two Kindergarten sections.
